



**Lot 187 SPLATTER DECORATED FLASK.** 13 ½". Applied lip. Rough pontil. A large piece, probably American, first one we've seen. If you collect large bottles, with white splatter, here's your piece. Grades About Mint. Est. \$100-200. MB \$50.



**Lot 188 BARBER BOTTLE** with original stopper. 7 ½" Multifiori design. A beautiful "thousand flower" barber bottle with pontil. A nice design, this one is in a more pastel shade and is quite elaborate. Always a favorite with collectors. About Mint. Est. \$100-200. MB \$80.



**Lot 189 BARBER BOTTLE** with original stopper. 8 ¼". Multifiori design. Another wonderful piece that compliments the previous lot. There's speculation on the age of some of the multifiori pieces, we believe they were made for a myriad of time, possibly from Victorian to mid 20<sup>th</sup> Century. Regardless, they are so beautiful and the work involved in making them is so time consuming, it's not really a huge issue with collectors when they were made. Having said that, these appear to be turn of the century, Italian. This one is also pontiled, the original stoppers are more from an earlier period bottle. This is a beautiful example in deeper reds, blues and greens. About Mint. Est. \$100-200. MB \$80.



**Lot 190 BARBER BOTTLE.** 9". Similar in design to Holiner page 30. A beautiful red, white, blue and jade green example with a pontil and sheared lip. Another gorgeous piece, this could be Italian, turn of the century. Grades About Mint. Est. \$100-200. MB \$70.



**Lot 191 OLD TAYLOR DECANTER** with stopper. 9 1/2" Cut into glass, this is a somewhat primitive method of putting the name into glass. Looks like it could have been done by hand. A scarce decanter. Grades Near Mint with some very minor interior haze. Est. \$100-200. MB \$50.



**Lot 192 MARYLAND RESERVE DECANTER** 9 1/2". With original stopper. Gold lettering on this scarce decanter. Has some minor interior stain, otherwise at least Near Mint. Lettering is in almost perfect condition. Est. \$100-200. MB \$50.



**Lot 193 HANDLED DECANTER** enamel decoration and original stopper. 9 1/2". Applied handle. A fairly elaborate decanter with gold, green, yellow and white enamel decoration. A unique and beautiful piece. It's not often we see this style with the applied handle. About Mint—enamel is 100% intact. Est. \$100-200. MB \$50.



**Lot 194 BLOWN DECANTER** with applied rigaree and stopper. 8 3/4". 1820-40. A nice example with a sunburst design stopper. Pontil. A simple and elegant shape. Grades About Mint. Est. \$100-200. MB \$50.



**Lot 195 BLOWN DECANTER** 8 1/4' 1820-40. With applied neck rings and original mushroom style stopper. Ground pontil. Similar to the previous lot, this one has a ground pontil and the rings are plain. Another oldie but goodie. Grades About Mint. Est. \$100-200. MB \$50.
