



Lot 52 CAL BOTTLING CO. EXPORT BEER SPLIT 6 7/8". M-51. A scarce split in a lighter than normal color. About Mint. Est. \$30-50. MB \$20.



Lot 53 SAN JOSE BOTTLING CO SAN JOSE CAL. 7 1/2" M-225. We have a great assortment of splits in this auction, here's a crude and whittled example. Has a 1/16" flake off top and some scratches—basically it needs cleaning. A crude one that is almost Near Mint. Est. \$20-40. MB \$10.



Lot 54 SUNSET BOTTLING CO. SAN FRANCISCO with monogram. 7 1/2" M-253. A fairly hard to find split, this one has the wire bale and is almost About Mint. A couple scratches but generally a fine condition bottle in a lighter than normal color. We won't mention the tooled tops on these unless they are applied, which is rare for these bottles. Est. \$30-50. MB \$30.



Lot 55 ETNA BREWERY ETNA MILLS 7 5/8" M -91. Another half-pint, this one isn't too rare but is About Mint. Est. \$30-40. MB \$20.



Lot 56 B. & J. OAKLAND 7 3/8" M-29. An almost About Mint beer which we've not seen before. A medium light amber with some crudity and a big top. These only come in a half-pint. Est. \$40-60. MB \$30.



Lot 57 WUNDER BOTTLING CO. SAN FRANCISCO.CAL M-226. A scarce bottle and one of few Wunder beer bottles. Makes you wonder where they all went? Grades About Mint. Est. \$30-50. MB \$20.



Lot 58 ALABAMA BREWING CO. SAN FRANCISCO with monogram. M 2. A rare bottle that come in a few different colors. This is an average amber in About Mint. Just a hint of exterior stain. Est. \$ 30-50. MB \$20.



Lot 59 UNION BREWING AND MALTING CO. S.F. CAL M-275
Unlisted in half-pint. Has original wire bale and original stopper.
Super About Mint condition. A good one. Est. \$40-70. MB \$30.



Lot 60 ALABAMA BREWING CO. SAN FRANCISCO. 7 3/8". M- 4.
This is the scarcer of the Alabama bottles, would be considered more
of a golden amber. About Mint—a choice example with some crudity.
Est. \$40-70. MB \$30.



Lot 61 BUFFALO BREWING CO. M-39. These are considered very
scarce and this is the first we've sold. Has original wire bale and
stopper. Perfect condition, About Mint. Another great one. Est. \$40-
70. MB \$30.



Lot 62 SALINAS VALLEY BOTTLING CO. SALINAS, CAL. 7 5/8"
Unlisted. First one we've seen of this light to medium amber split.
Has some decent crudity and grades About Mint. Est. \$30-80. MB
\$30.



Lot 63 THOS. DOWNING HANFORD, CAL. NOT TO BE SOLD. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Crown top. Unlisted. A rare and unusual split from the sleepy little town of Hanford. Super condition, About Mint. Here's a rare one. Est. \$30-50. MB \$30.



Lot 64 ST. HELENA BOTTLING AND COLD STORAGE ST. HELENA CAL. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Crown top. M-244. Unlisted in the half-pint and crown top. A rare one in About Mint condition. It seems splits are generally in better condition, is it possible they didn't get used as much as the quarts and pints? Est. \$30-60. MB \$30.



Lot 65 THOS. DOWNING HANFORD, CAL. NOT TO BE SOLD. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Crown top. Unlisted. And yet another Downing bottle, this one is darker but way more whittled. About Mint. A real good one and rare. Est. \$30-50. MB \$30.



Lot 66 BUFFALO BREWING & CO. S.F. AGENCY with monogram. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". M-40 A very rare bottle with this top. These aren't listed in a half-pint. Has a tiny bruise on the mouth area, doesn't detract. Otherwise About Mint. Est. \$30-50. MB \$30.



Lot 67 GRACE BROS. BREWING SANTA ROSA, CAL. With monogram. 7 3/4". This bottle is not listed in Martin with the shoulders. It appears to have the same embossing pattern but is a different bottle. Superb condition with tons of embossing. Practically Mint. Est. \$40-70. MB \$30.



Lot 68 NATIONAL LAGER BEER H. ROHRBACHER AGT. STOCKTON, CAL. With monogram. 7 7/8". M-184 A super example in a golden amber with the original wire bale. About Mint—a real nice piece. Est. \$40-80. MB \$30.



Lot 69 RASPILLER BREWING CO. WEST BERKELEY 7 5/8" M-212. These are a fairly rare bird in the half-pint size. This has a couple minor scratches but is generally About Mint. A real good one if you don't have it, and you probably don't. Est. \$40-80. MB \$30.



Lot 70 MIRRASOUL BROS. S.F. M-167. 7 5/8" with wire bale for California Bottling Co. A nice light example, has a very tiny flake off lip. Another nice colored split. At least Near Mint. Est. \$30-60. MB \$30.



Lot 71 K&M OAKLAND M-134. Another rare bottle, this only comes in a half-pint. Tough one to find and the first we've offered. About Mint in a medium to light amber. Est.\$30-50. Mb \$30.



Lot 72 NORTH STAR S.F. CAL with embossed star. 7 7/8" M-186 with original wire bale. A rare little bottle, this one is in super condition and grades at least About Mint. Another tough one. Est. \$30-60. MB \$30.



Lot 73 BRECKENFELDER & JOCHEM OAKLAND, CAL. 9 1/4" With original wire bale and label. Another interesting piece, this is unlisted in this size and especially nice with the original lable for Valley Brew. Label is in about 90% perfect condition and of course you're bidding on a rare bottle. A nice brewery item. Bottle is About Mint. Est. \$60-120. MB \$40.



Lot 74 LABEL ONLY BUFFALO LAGER BEER 9 3/8" Crown top. Here's a turn of the century beer bottle with the famous buffalo jumping through the horseshoe. If you collect beers or labeled bottles, this is a good one. Label is wrinkled but 95% intact. Bottle has a small chip out of lip, you're essentially buying the label. Est. \$40-80. MB \$30.



Lot 75 RUHSTALLER'S GILD EDGE LAGER BEER 11 1/2" label over **Buffalo Brewing** quart bottle. Interesting use of another company's bottle. The beer was put out by Kenison & Co. in Auburn, CA.. Bottle is Near Mint, label is 95% intact. Est. \$40-80. MB \$30.



Lot 76 BUFFALO BREWING SACRAMENTO, CAL. M-37. 9 3/8" with wire bale and stopper. A pint sized example of this popular bottle. If you have the larger size, you've got to have this one. Grades About Mint with just a little dirt inside. Est. \$30-50. MB \$20.



Lot 77 HOWARD'S THORBURN ST UPPER BROOKS MANCHASTER with embossed horse and rider. 8 1/4" with applied top. One of the more dramatic embossed horse and riders we've seen, this has a great drippy top and nice green color. Condition is About Mint. Est. \$0-120. MB \$40.



Lot 78 TIP TRAY SAN FRANCISCO AGENCY BUFFALO BREWING CO. FAMOUS BEERS with monogram. 4 3/8". A rough, but nonetheless nice little tray, first we've sold. Gold, white, red and black make up this example. About a 3 on a 1-10 level. Great go-with for Buffalo Brewing. Est. \$30-70. MB \$30.



Lot 79 SOUVENIR-OMAHA TIP TRAY 4 3/16". A nice little tray with a beautiful young lady, this could probably be cleaned a little bit to bring out its full beauty. This is about a 7 on a 1-10 scale. Nice piece. Est. \$60-150. MB \$50.



Lot 80 TIP TRAY BUFFALO BREWING CO. SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA 4 3/8" also reads San Francisco Exposition 1915 The nations paying homage to San Francisco. Features a harem of beautiful girls and ships in the background that says "through the Panama Canal to the Golden Gate. Highly graphic and colorful, this one is dented but is very hard to see from the front. Graphics rate about a 7, metal condition is about a 4. Nice go-with. Est. \$200-400. MB \$200.



Lot 81 BUFFALO BREWING CO. S.F. AGENCY 7 3/4" with original wire bale. M-39. Unlisted in clear. A neat little example, this one is the first we've sold. Grades About Mint. A must have for the Buffalo Brewing collector. Est. \$50-100. MB \$30.



Lot 82 FREDRICKSBURG LAGER BEER S.F. BOTTLING COMPANY with shield and monogram. 7 1/2". M-95. A tough little split to acquire, this is listed as very scarce. Has some wear you'd expect from a beer bottle, generally about Near Mint. Est. \$30-70. MB \$30.



Lot 83 JOHN RAPP & SON S.F. CAL. 7 3/4" with crown top. M-211, unlisted in clear. Another rare beer, this is a little dirty and has a few tiny bruises around the top. Nice amethyst coloration. Est \$30-60. MB \$20.



Lot 84 ENTERPRISE BREWING CO S.F. CAL 7 7/8" Split with original stopper. An unlisted beer in clear, this has an inch long moon shaped crack in the left shoulder. Nonetheless, a good one if you're trying to complete a collection. First we've seen. Est. \$30-50. MB \$20.



Lot 85 FREDRICKSBURGH BOTTLING CO. S. F. with monogram 11 ½" Applied top. M-101. A whittled example of this well known beer. A super example of this bottle, has a little stain but generally very presentable. A green line in the shoulder looks like a scratch. A light cleaning and this bottle appears Mint. Est. \$40-70. MB \$30.



Lot 86 BUFFALO BR'G CO. SACRAMENTO 12 1/8" M-41. Here's the rarer example with the super whittle and crudity. Tough to find a better one, a tiny bit of stain but a truly beautiful bottle. About Mint. Est. \$40-90. MB \$30.



Lot 87 NATIONAL BOTTLING SAN FRANCISCO CAL ADOLPH B. LANG with embossed eagle. 11 5/8". M-79. A super example with a nice light to medium coloration and a big, bold bird! Hard to improve, grades at least About Mint. Est. \$50-100. MB \$40.



Lot 88 FREDRICKSBURGH BOTTLING CO S.F. with monogram. 11 3/4". M-100. Here's the cousin to lot 85, this is the red whittled example versus the green ones. Frankly, this one is less and considered more rare. This could use a little cleaning as it has some minor stain and a few scratches but is really Near Mint. A good one if you don't have it. Est. \$50-100. MB \$40.



Lot 89 ENTERPRISE BREWING CO. S.F. CAL with monogram. 11 7/8" Although there are a few different variants of the Enterprise bottle, this one is unlisted. Has some decent crudity and a good light color. Could use a good cleaning as it has some interior dirt, not really enough to affect the About Mint grade. Est. \$40-70. MB \$30.



Lot 90 KLEIN & HOFHEINZ ROCHESTER, N.Y. with applied top. 11 5/8". "PAT 85" on base. What we have here is a beer shaped older bottle that was probably a mineral water, despite the German name. A real dandy it is, too, lots of beautiful blue and About Mint. This one has got to be rare—a special bottle. Est. \$200-300. MB \$150.
