



Lot 91 DR. W.R. MERWIN & CO. NEW YORK. 5 7/8". Smooth base. A neat little medicine with applied top. Has some decent crudity and grades About Mint. Est. \$30-60. MB \$30.



Lot 92 J. LIPPMAN SAN FRANCISCO 6 5/8" Applied top. Tough to find a better Lippman, aside from a tiny ding on a side panel, this is a nice deep aqua and loaded with whittle and character. The ding is very minor, bottle is otherwise Mint. Est. \$40-70. MB \$30.



Lot 93 G.T. BARNEY PERFUMER 7 1/8" with applied top and open pontil. A very nice paneled cologne, this one is whittled to the gills. A pretty aqua bottle. Glistens like a million diamonds in the sun. About Mint. Est. \$40-70. MB \$30.



Lot 94 CHAS BERNARD SAN FRANCISCO 6 5/8" Applied top. A nice green example of this spice from "the city". Good overall crudity and besides just a hint of stain, About Mint. These are tough in any color but regular aqua. Est. \$50-90. MB \$30.



Lot 95 UNMARKED FLORIDA WATER 9". Applied top, smooth base. Found in the west, here's a beautiful window bottle with some nice whittle and overall appeal. You see a hundred aqua examples of these for every blue one. Grades About Mint. Est. \$50-100. MB \$30.



Lot 96 CRANE & BRIGHAM S.F. COLOGNE 5/18". Tooled top with fern-like motif embossed on the reverse. A neat little piece from San Francisco, some big time bottles come with the C&B name on them. These are rarely seen, probably made before the turn of the century. Grades About Mint. Est. \$50-100. MB \$40.



Lot 97 SOUTHERN PACIFIC CO. HOSPITAL DEPARTMENT 5 5/8". Tooled top. We're told these are a tough bottle to find although we've seen a few. These were put out for the Southern Pacific Railway Company. This one grades About Mint. Est. \$40-80. MB \$30.



Lot 98 UNMARKED UTILITY BOTTLE. 7 1/2". Applied top, smooth base. Just. another unassuming bottle with loads of appeal. A beautiful blue color, it has loads of overall whittle and character. Who says every bottle needs to be embossed? Probably made in the late 1870's or 80's. Grades About Mint. Est. \$40-70. MB \$30.



Lot 99 QUALITY ACCURACY & PURE DRUGS KROUGH'S SALINAS CAL. 5 5/8". Tooled lip. A desirable and About Mint drug store bottle from Salinas. These come in a number of sizes. Est. \$30-60. MB \$30.



Lot 100 WM. R. WARNER & CO. PHILADELPHIA 6" with tooled lip. This has got to be a tough Warner bottle as it's the first we've seen and is not included in the Ojea book. At least we haven't seen one. It could use a cleaning which would render it probably About Mint. Nice blue bottle and a good addition to any Warner collection. Est. \$40-80. MB \$30.



Lot 101 DR. LIEBIG'S GERMAN INVIGORATOR 400 GEARY ST. S.F. 6 5/8". Tooled top. A brilliant amber example, these are often very close to appearing applied. This one is About Mint. Has some decent overall crudity. Est. \$40-80. MB \$30.



Lot 102 GLOVER'S IMPERIAL DISTEMBER REMEDY 5 1/4". Applied top. A nice teal coloration on this popular medicine. These come in a number of colors including amber. This one is fairly crude and in About Mint condition. Est. \$50-100. MB \$30.



Lot 103 PEARL'S WHITE GLYCERINE 6 1/2" Applied top. This beauty has about as much crudity as you can want on a medicine. Just a great little piece. About Mint. Est. \$40-80. MB \$30.



Lot 104 COLOGNE with Pocahontas motif. 4 3/4" This is a popular cologne, this one has the rolled top and open pontil. Very crude and a good addition to any collection. Grades About Mint. Est. \$100-300. MB \$100.



Lot 105 M.B. ROBERTS VEGETABLE EMBROCATION. 5". Applied top and open pontil. This is a good example, was lightly cleaned and is nicely whittled with a beg fat open pontil. Not aqua, this is a greenish color. About Mint. Est. \$200-400. MB \$200.



Lot 106 COLLAS 8 DAUPHINE A PARIS 2". Flared lip. These are interesting bottles, found in San Francisco, they are very early and probably made in Paris. A neat part of San Francisco history. About Mint. Est. \$30-60. MB \$30.
